Re: 2011 Membership Fees and Insurance Program

Dear Associations

I write to provide you with an exciting update regarding two key elements of Netball Victoria affiliation – membership fees and insurance.

2011 Membership Fees

Netball Victoria is pleased to advise that membership fees for 2011 will not change from 2010 levels. This is obviously a positive result for netball in Victoria and something which the Board and senior management have worked hard over the past few months to ensure this outcome could be achieved.

In addition to keeping membership fees at 2010 levels, Netball Victoria aims to provide an improved level of service and support to Associations, Leagues, Clubs and individual members in 2011. These improvements will include:

- Having a greater presence out in the field
- Being more responsive to the needs of our members
- Providing improved education and training programs and resources
- Providing an improved insurance program

Australian Netball Insurance Program

Following a recent tender process by Netball Australia, on behalf of all affiliated State/Territory Netball Organisations, there has been a change in the insurance arrangements for all Associations, affiliated clubs and their members.

Willis Australia has been appointed as Netball's new Insurance Brokers replacing JLT. Willis is one of the largest insurance brokers in the world and has operated in Australia for over 50 years. Willis has had a long association with various sporting organisations throughout Australia and is the current Insurance Broker for Netball NSW and Netball ACT.

Willis has provided an enhanced Insurance Program for all Associations and their members for the following classes of business:

- **Public Liability/Professional Indemnity**
- **Management Liability cover for Associations and Clubs**
- **Sports Injury/Personal Accident**
- **Asset Program for Property & Equipment for each Association**
