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## JUNIOR PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

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You must ensure the standards of the Fair Play Code are applied by demonstrating the five core values that will lead to fair play for all:

- Integrity
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Fairness
- Safety

In addition to Netball Victoria's and Stonnington City Netball Association's (SCNA) General Code of Conduct, as a player in any activity held by or under the auspices of Netball Victoria, Region, an Affiliated Association/League or Club you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any such activity or event.

- 1. Fully comply with the Child Safety in Netball Code of Conduct.
- 2. Participate because you enjoy it, not just to please parents and coaches.
- 3. Play by the rules.
- 4. Know the rules.
- 5. Participate fairly and safely.
- 6. Abide by decisions, without argument or bad temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players; deliberately fouling or provoking an opponent; and throwing/damaging equipment is unacceptable and will result in suspension from play for players and possible banning of entrance to the Centre during competition.
- 7. Captains have the right to approach an umpire during an interval or after the game for clarification of any rule (11U + Competitions. In 9U coaches may approach the umpires).
- 8. Approach the umpire in a courteous and polite way.
- 9. Cooperate with your coach, and other players.
- 10. Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
- 11. Ensure that at all times your behaviour is fair and reasonable. Engage in good sporting conduct.
- 12. Be a patient and enthusiastic, supporter of fellow players.
- 13. Applaud all good play, by your own team and opponents.
- 14. Be a responsible team member.
- 15. Be on time.
- 16. Encourage and assist all players.
- 17. Attend all training sessions.
- 18. Ensure you always bring the appropriate uniform and equipment to training and/or games.
- 19. Do not engage in practices that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco and drug use).
- 20. Respect and acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play (volunteers, scorers, coaches, timekeepers, administrators and umpires)
